Some hard facts regarding CSA and UL Standards:

The Hard Facts; CSA22.2 / 247-92 vs UL325

- Canada's voluntary National Standard for door operators is CAN/CSA 22.2 / 247-92.
 - As of August 29, 2010, Canada's National Standard is not being revised.
- United States' voluntary National Standard for door operators is ANSI/UL325-2010.
 - As of August 29, 2010, the United States National Standard is being revised.

ANSI/UL325 Revised Requirements

- The revised requirement is: in order to work in "momentary pressure" mode, commercial/industrial operators must monitor a primary external entrapment protection device (photo cells, sensing edge) or must revert to "constant pressure" mode.
- Secondary non-monitored protection devices (such as a pneumatic sensing edge) are permissible.

Manaras-Opera's Position on the Canadian Market

- Since Canada's National Standard is not changing, Manaras-Opera will continue to offer the same products it always offered in Canada. It is business as usual.
