How to Read an Accredited Certification Body Mark

Our operators and panels are tested by independent **Accredited Certification Bodies**, such as **CSA** and **UL**. You can find variations of the markings below on our products. They are easy to interpret, here's how...



Possible Markings



If a product carries any of these markings, it means:

- 1) That the ACB has tested representative samples of the product and determined that it meets given requirements. These requirements are voluntary, consensus-based nationally recognized standards, ex: CAN/CSA 22.2/247 and ANSI/UL325:2010.
- 2) That the ACB performs regular surprise inspections of the manufacturing facilities in order to verify the conformity of the processes and products to the standard(s).
